

Instructions for Taking Photographs

1. Take a photo whenever a Track Log is filled out.

Track photos:

- Take pictures of both the individual tracks as well as the trail pattern.
- In each photo, include a scale measurement. This could be a ruler, or something of known size like a penny.
- Take pictures under several different lighting conditions, to ensure one of them will be able to show the tracks well. Take a picture in sun, in shade, with side light from a flashlight, etc.

Sign photos:

- Take a close up of the sign, as well as a broader view of its location.
- In each photo, include a scale measurement.
- If lighting is difficult, take pictures under several different lighting conditions, as mentioned above.

Level 3 and 4 species: Pay special attention to making sure the photos will be clear!

2. Tell the GPS Log person the number of photographs that were taken at the location.
